

Hate Crime Reporting

Introduction

The SBI provides assistance to agencies in hate crime reporting by providing forms, reporting assistance and statistical analysis. From 1992 through 1994, the SBI received a limited number of hate crime reports. In 1995, fifty-nine agencies reported 52 hate crime incidents to the SBI; in 1996, eighty-three agencies reported 34 hate crime incidents; in 1997, twenty-two agencies reported 42 hate crime incidents; and in 1998 seventeen agencies reported 40 hate crime incidents; and in 1999, fifteen agencies reported 31 hate crime incidents; in 2000, fifteen agencies reported 39 hate crime incidents, in 2001, forty-one agencies reported 85 hate crime incidents and in 2002, twenty-nine agencies reported 62 hate crime Incidents.
