²The term "victim" may refer to a person, businesses, institution or society as a whole. The total number of victims in a given incident is sum of victims associated with each offense that took place within the incident.

³The term "known offender" does not imply that the identity of the suspect is known, but only that an attribute of the suspect is identified which distinguishes him/her from an unknown offende
