<sup>1</sup>For counting purposes, one offense is counted for each victim of a "crime against person." One offense is counted for each distinct operation of "crime against property," regardless of the number of victims.

<sup>2</sup>The term "victim" may refer to a person, businesses, institution or society as a whole. The total number of victims in a given incident is the sum of victims associated with each offense that took place within the incident.

<sup>3</sup>The term "known offender" does not imply that the identity of the suspect is known, but only that an attribute of the suspect is identified which distinguishes him/her from an unknown offender.

<sup>4</sup> The actual number of known offenders is 57. However, some offenders committed more than one offense per incident and are, therefore, counted more than once in this table.
