

Hate Crime Reporting

Methodology

This section contains tables that address the volume and types of bias-motivated criminal incidents reported to the SBI during 2007. Criminal incidents can involve more than one offense, victim, or offender. For counting purposes, one offense is counted for each victim of a "crime against person." One offense is counted for each distinct operation of "crime against property," regardless of the number of victims. The total number of victims in a given incident is the sum of victims associated with each offense that took place within the incident.
